SKIN CANCER ALERT: OVER 1 MILLION CASES DIAGNOSED LAST YEAR

Skin cancer is the most common type of cancer diagnosed in the United States. Alarmingly, 1 in 5 Americans will develop some form of skin cancer during their lifetime. The two most common forms of skin cancer are basal cell carcinoma (BCC) and squamous cell carcinoma (SCC), which tend to arise on sun exposed skin, and fortunately have a better than 95% five-year cure rate if detected and treated early.

Melanoma, although less common, can be fatal if allowed to progress and spread. It has increased by 2000% since 1930. This cancer can strike anyone, but those at increased risk include fair skinned sun sensitive people, anyone with a history of sunburns, those with many moles, and having a close relative who has had melanoma.

Prevention and early detection of skin cancer are the best ways of addressing this progressing epidemic. The American Academy of Dermatology recommends year round daily use of broad spectrum sunscreens with a sun protection factor (SPF) of 15 or higher, wearing protective hats and clothing, seeking shade whenever possible and annual exams for those with risk factors for skin cancer.

ADULT ACNE: THE CURSE OF THE TEENAGE YEARS IN ADULTHOOD

Acne is a condition of the teenage years, right? Wrong! Women, in particular, continue to struggle with acne into adulthood, with more than 50% of women reporting acne breakouts in their 20's, 30's and 40's. This stubborn acne is often pronounced on the chin, jawline, and neck, and flares cyclically.

Aging skin is drier and less tolerant of many of the medications that teenagers might use, and a gentle cleansing and moisturizing regimen can go a long way towards helping your acne. In the past few years, the range of therapies for acne has broadened, including topical medications in newer formulations that adults are better able to tolerate. Systemic medications such as oral antibiotics are also quite useful, as are hormonal therapies such as oral contraceptive pills or Spironolactone. For a few women with severe or unremitting acne, Isotretinoin is a remarkably successful option. Your dermatologist can work with you to create a unique acne program that includes a skincare regimen, medical therapies, and procedural treatments to diminish your adult acne once and for all!
